Frequently Asked Questions

- **Are you still doing 10.10.2020?**

Yes! We are inviting small groups and families to participate in 10.10.2020 on a smaller or virtual scale. We are inviting groups to use this day as *preparation* for our larger service event that we hope will take place on April 17th, 2021. Check out the website for ideas for projects for both dates.

- **Does my project need to take place on Saturday, October 10th, 2020 or April 17th, 2021?**

No! While we are hoping to make 4.17.2021 a day of service throughout the Archdiocese, we understand that some service must take place outside of these 24 hours. We encourage you to find a time in late April that works for you and your group! And we still invite you to use the #cincy200 regardless of when you participate in service.

- **How do I coordinate a project?**

We encourage small communities to work together. Schools may collect items during the week for the parish youth group to assemble on the weekend and the men's group to deliver the following week. Check in with your parish, school or other faith entity. You are also welcome to participate as an individual or family. Please see our volunteer ideas list for a variety of suggestions!

- **What types of projects can I do?**

The religious communities of this Archdiocese primarily came to the region to work with immigrants, so we encourage a special focus on serving the stranger among us. Today, we recognize that a "stranger" may be our neighbors, the poor, those from other cultures, or even someone that attends our Church. We are inviting everyone to reach out and welcome others, whomever they may be. We have a variety of ideas on our ideas list!

- **Why do I have to submit my project plans to you?**

Submitting your project idea or plan helps us in two ways. We can share your service idea with other groups that may be looking for something to do. Also, our communications office is looking for ways to highlight service efforts. We may use your project to spotlight work being done throughout the area!

- **What if I cannot physically do a project?**

Our volunteer ideas list has ways for people of any age and ability to participate. We also like to reaffirm the importance and power of prayer. Whether it be praying for groups of people, service groups or for the Archdiocese, setting aside a special time of prayer on October 10th and/or April 17th is a wonderful way to participate!
